Scholarship Awards & Eligibility:

Two scholarships will be awarded annually:

- **Elizabeth Ellen Smith Legacy Scholarship – Young Woman Award – \$500**
 - **Elizabeth Ellen Smith Legacy Scholarship – Young Man Award – \$500**
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Eligibility

Applicants must:

- **Be homeschooled or planning to graduate from a homeschool program.**
- **Be between the ages of 16–19**
- **Demonstrate a personal faith in Jesus Christ.**

- Exhibit a strong commitment to family and service.
- Plan to pursue college, trade school, ministry training, entrepreneurship, or another purposeful path after graduation.
- Be active in church, community, or volunteer service.

Selection Criteria

Faith (30%)

- Demonstrates Christian character.
- Lives out biblical principles.
- Participates in church or ministry activities.

Family (30%)

- Shows honor and respect toward parents and family.
- Serves siblings, grandparents, or extended family.
- Values relationships and contributes to the home.

Service (30%)

- Volunteers in church, community, or ministry.
- Encourages and mentors others.
- Demonstrates kindness and compassion.

Leadership and Future Goals (10%)

- Possesses a vision for using their gifts to impact others.

Application Requirements

1. Personal Essay (500–750 words)

Essay Theme:

"How have faith, family, and service shaped who you are, and how do you hope to make a difference in the lives of others?"

Applicants are encouraged to share:

- Their testimony or faith journey.
- Ways they serve their family and community.
- Their future goals and aspirations.
- How they hope to honor God through their gifts and calling.

2. Parent Recommendation

A brief letter describing the student's character, work ethic, and commitment to family.

3. Pastor or Ministry Leader Recommendation

A letter describing the applicant's Christian character and involvement in church or ministry.

4. Activity and Service Resume
